ORDER

AND NOW, May 25, 1955, pursuant to Order entered December 29, 1954, and after recommendations by the Swarthmore Swim Club by its attorney, A. Sidney Johnson, Jr., and agreement therewith by James N. Robertson, Esquire, counsel for Plaintiffs, it is ordered and directed that there be erected a cyclone type fence six feet in height plus three strands of barbed wire on the following location:

Along the easterly line of the Club's property being the boundary line between the Borough of Swarthmore and the Township of Springfield, along the northeasterly line of the Club's property and along the rear of those properties of the Plaintiffs, Liddell, et al, which adjoin the Club property and continuing thence across the Club property to the line of the right-of-way of the railroad at a point approximately two hundred seventy-six feet from the center line of Riverview Avenue and thence along the line of the right-of-way of the railroad to the rear line of the Club property first above mentioned as shown on the plan hereto attached, the said fence being approximately one foot from each said line.
