ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

1. The name of this corporation is Swarthmore Swim Club, and the location of its registered office is 401 Thayer Road, Swarthmore, Pennsylvania.

2. This corporation was formed under the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as "The Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended, by Decree of this Court entered the first day of March, 1954, and the original Articles were recorded in the Office for the Recording of Deeds, etc. in and for the County of Delaware, Pennsylvania, on March 2, 1954, in Charter Book M. at page 432.

3. The resolution authorizing the application to the Court for this Amendment was approved and consented to in writing by all the members entitled to vote thereon, being all of the members.

4. The amendment to the existing Articles of Incorporation is that Article 7 thereof is amended to read as follows:

"7. The corporation is to be organized upon a stock share basis, each share having a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and the corporation is limited to 1,000 shares. Said shares are non-assessable, non-negotiable, non-profit-sharing, non-interest-bearing, and do not represent an obligation of the corporation."

THESE ARTICLES have been duly executed this day of June, A. D. 1955.
